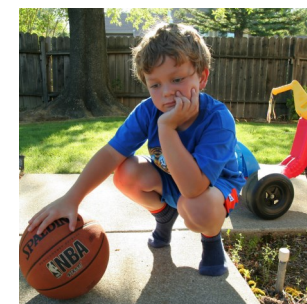
COST AND FEES

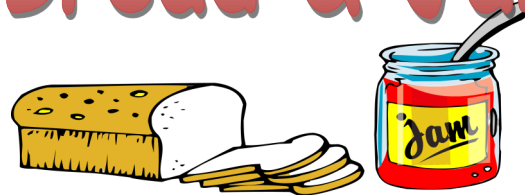
