

Rules:

- Each photo must be a 5x7 print. No photo albums will be allowed. Do not mount on any type of paper or mat.
- Identify the sheet with entrant's name, category of picture, school/club name written on the back.
- You may enter one photo per category.
- Any camera may be used to take photos including digital but it MUST be printed out.

PHOTO STORY

Enter a series of photos that show an interesting subject. You must have a minimum of 4 pictures. Photos must be mounted in a logical order. Include captions which help to explain the story. This category requires mounting on a poster board.

4-H EXHIBITS

Bring an exhibit of your 4-H project and display it at Tremendous Tuesday!

- Use a tri-fold display board that you purchased or made yourself to attach important information of important steps in completing the object that you are demonstrating, or about something you are interested in.
- Add enough information to showcase your topic.
- Add a finished project or product to show completion of the project to display in front of the board.
- Bring items to set in front of your display to enhance your exhibit.
- Exhibits must be printed and on a tri fold for this competition.

COLLECTIONS DISPLAY

Display one of your collections.

- Use a tri-fold board, tablecloth of fabric to highlight the collection and give depth and interest to the display.
- Each collection must be labeled with the name of the collection.
- Collections must have interesting facts printed and displayed with collection.
- Name and school/club of the displayer must be visible.

BREADBAKING CONTEST



All 4th— 12th grade 4-H Members are eligible to enter the County Bread Baking Contest.

Remember to bring a copy of the recipe with your baked good.

4th- Cornbread muffins, plain or any variety (bring 3 to judge)

5th-Biscuits, rolled & cut, plain (bring 3 to judge) 6th-Cookies or brownies (bring 3 to judge)

7th-3 decorated cupcakes

8th- 1 cake of any kind

9th-12th- Any kind of yeast loaf bread or rolls















Approximately 20 acts will perform at the Knox County 4-H Tremendous Tuesday, after having performed at a school/club show. Acts to perform will receive invitations by mail. Invited acts will perform the same routine that was performed at the school show.
